**Town of Chatham Beach Information**

**Effective January 1, 2014 Chatham beaches are SMOKE FREE per the Board of Health Regulation (Tobacco Control Regulation, Section IV)**

**Chatham Resident property taxpayer sticker or Chatham Non-Resident visitor pass required (except Oyster Pond).** No children under 10 years of age may attend any beach unless accompanied by an adult.

**Lifeguards on duty 9:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. June 26th to September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

**Beaches with Lifeguards:** Chatham Resident/Chatham Non-resident Property Taxpayer sticker or visitor pass required (except Oyster Pond).

**Harding's Beach:** Resident/non-resident taxpayer sticker or visitor pass.

(U.S. Military personnel, active or retired with a valid Military picture ID, are allowed free access to Harding's Beach.)

**Ridgevale Beach:** Resident/non-resident taxpayer sticker or visitors pass.

**Cockle Cove Beach:** Resident/non-resident taxpayer sticker or visitors pass.

**School House Pond:** Resident/non-resident taxpayer sticker ONLY.

**Oyster Pond Beach:** No sticker or pass required.

**Lighthouse Beach:** (No Lifeguards) Passes for parking on Bridge St. to access Lighthouse Beach are required between July 1st and Labor Day, daily 9 am to 5 pm.

1. Residents/Taxpayers – Any Chatham resident/taxpayer sticker (Beach, Transfer Station, Combination, Recycle, North Beach ORV) is acceptable.

2. Visitors – The same visitors pass obtained for any pay beach.

**The following are prohibited:**

Unauthorized vehicles on the beaches; alcoholic beverages; discharge of firearms or fireworks; glass containers; overnight camping; open or closed fires (gas grills permitted), operation of boats, wind surfers or similar within 150 of designated swim areas; destruction of dunes, always use walkways or paths; entering roped off areas for piping plovers.
