COUNCIL ON AGING/CENTER FOR ACTIVE LIVING (COA/CFAL) CLOSURE INFORMATION AND WEATHER POLICY:

Council on Aging closure information will be posted online and on-air by the following radio stations: WQRC 99.9, WKPE 103.9, WOCN 104.7, WFCC 107.5 FM. If the Monomoy School System is closed due to weather, all COA activities including the bus are cancelled. If schools are on vacation, the COA Director will determine closures with safety in mind. The staff will be at the Senior Center to provide information and support, unless Town Hall is closed, in which case the Senior Center will close entirely.

BASIC SUPPLIES TO HAVE ON-HAND AT HOME:

1. Working flashlight, radio and batteries (NO open lit candles)
2. Fuel for a generator (if you have one)
3. A full tank of gas for your vehicle
4. Non-cordless home telephone and a fully-charged cell phone
5. 3-4 day supply of food
6. 1 gallon of water per person/per day
7. 1 week supply of medication and other necessary equipment (such as oxygen)
8. Pet food, water, and supplies
9. Basic first aid kit

SPECIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

If you, or other members of your household would require special assistance in the event of a power outage or an emergency evacuation, please complete and return the "Special Assistance Program Enrollment" form so that we can make special arrangements in advance. The Special Assistance Program Enrollment is a preplanning form designed to supply the Chatham Emergency Management Team with information to help assist you during an emergency.
